Legacy SROI Reporting Processes and Alaska Statute Requirements



TP Elects to File Electronically as of 07/22/2013

- ❖ TP's profile is submitted and approved prior to 07/22/2013
- ❖ TP is responsible for filing New Claims (where date Claim Admin had Knowledge of Injury is greater than or equal to 07/22/2013)
- ❖ TP is responsible for filing Legacy Claims (where date Claim Admin had Knowledge of Injury is less than 07/22/2013 that includes claims where a paper report was sent that received a Jurisdiction Claim Number)
- ❖ TP continues to submit paper forms for Legacy Claims that have compensation activity (see revised 07-6104b and 07-6105)

TP Elects to Continue on Paper After 07/22/2013

- ❖ TP must follow EDI requirements on paper submissions
- ❖ TP submits Profile at: <http://www.adoledi.info/profile-new>
 - ADOL approves TP's Profile
 - TP's Profile will be added automatically to ADOL's Profile with TP's Insurers and Claim Admins
 - TP's Profile will be added with the Sender entry marked as inactive
- ❖ Any claim entered via the web portal by ADOL continues with ADOL for the life of the claim


- ❖ TP submits FROI and SROI reports on revised forms selecting the correct EDI Claims R3 data elements
- ❖ *ADOL to update certification language on 07-6104b and 07-6105 to reflect non-EDI TPs*
 - 07-6104b: I certify I have mailed the original Compensation Report to the employee at the address above and a copy (SROI Legacy Claim) OR filed electronically (SROI New Claim) to the Division of Workers' Compensation.
 - 07-6105: I certify I have mailed the original Controversion (Denial) Notice to the employee at the address above and a copy (SROI Legacy Claim) OR filed electronically (SROI New Claim) to the Division of Workers' Compensation.

Requirements if Not Submitting FROI/SROI Through EDI





Data Being Requested



The data being requested is the same as if the TPs were submitting through EDI:

- ❖ TPs use revised forms effective 07/22/2013 that reflect required EDI data fields
- ❖ TPs need to understand EDI Claims R3 reporting standards and ADOL's requirement tables
- ❖ The revised forms are based on the IAIABC Claims Release 3 Standards

Alaska Non-EDI Requirements Overview

ADOL Claims EDI Requirement Tables

1) **Event Table: Required Reports.**

What reports should be filed and when. Comprised of FROI, SROI and Periodic Event Tables.

2) **Element Requirement Table: Data needed on the reports.**

What are the requirements on the reports. Comprised of FROI Requirements and Conditions, SROI Requirements and Conditions, and SROI Benefit Requirements and Conditions.

3) **Edit Matrix: Applied Editing**

What are the specific edits that will be applied to the reports. Comprised of Valid Value, Population Restrictions, Sequencing and Match Data Table.

Alaska Non-EDI Requirements Overview

Trading Partners must have a clear understanding of...

- ❖ When this data is to be provided
- ❖ What data is expected
- ❖ How data will be validated
- ❖ What data format is to be used
- ❖ What paper form is to be used to transport the data
