### Alaska Claims Release 3.1 - v1.3 Requirements and Reminder to Test

Date: March 11, 2021

ADOL has posted their EDI Claims Release 3.1 Requirement Tables and Implementation Guide, Version 1.3 (Rev: 03/11/21, Effective Date: 05/17/21). The Requirement Tables are immediately available for download on the EDI Requirements Page of the ADOL EDI Claims Website: <https://adoledi.info/requirements>. The ADOL Change Log tab within the Requirement Tables describe the changes to ADOL's Requirements.

The ADOL Implementation Guide is available for download on the Implementation Guide Page of the ADOL EDI Claims Website: <https://adoledi.info/guide>.

Just a reminder that the testing period for AK Trading Partners (Direct Reporters) and EDI Vendors for testing IAIABC Claims Release 3.1 started on February 8, 2021.

AK EDI Trading Partners submitting Claims data directly in R3.1 Data Format and EDI Vendors are required to complete the Test Plan. The ADOL Test Plan can be found at <https://adoledi.info>, select Implementation Info.

Exceptions: No testing is required for AK Web Entry filers. In some cases, if a Trading Partner is using an EDI Vendor, the EDI Vendor will coordinate and/or perform the testing on behalf of the Trading Partner.

Test/Production Indicator (DN 0104) located in position 82 of the Header Record should be set to 'T' for all testing.

Testing for Mandatory Reporting ends May 10, 2021 and Mandate Date for ADOL EDI Claims Release 3.1 is May 17, 2021.
